Theme & Concept

Deep Roots, Wide Range

"They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

Brown

This year's theme, Deep Roots, Wide Range, is a western theme brought to life through a palette of light browns, blues, greens, and tans, each one pulled straight from the Wild West itself. The browns reference the terrain of the Wild West, sun-baked open sand and golden, sun-beaten dry grass stretching wide across the range.

Inspiration & Color Palette

Green

The greens reference the cactus, the unyielding desert flower, a plant that sinks deep roots into hard ground and thrives anyway.

Tan

The tans reference the shirts cowboys and cowgirls often wear, white fabric stained by dust or simply faded soft by the sun. Together, the palette tells one story: things that are worn, weathered, and sun-touched, yet still standing. Despite everything we go through as young followers of Christ, we are still standing strong, deeply rooted, and built for the wide open range.

Blue

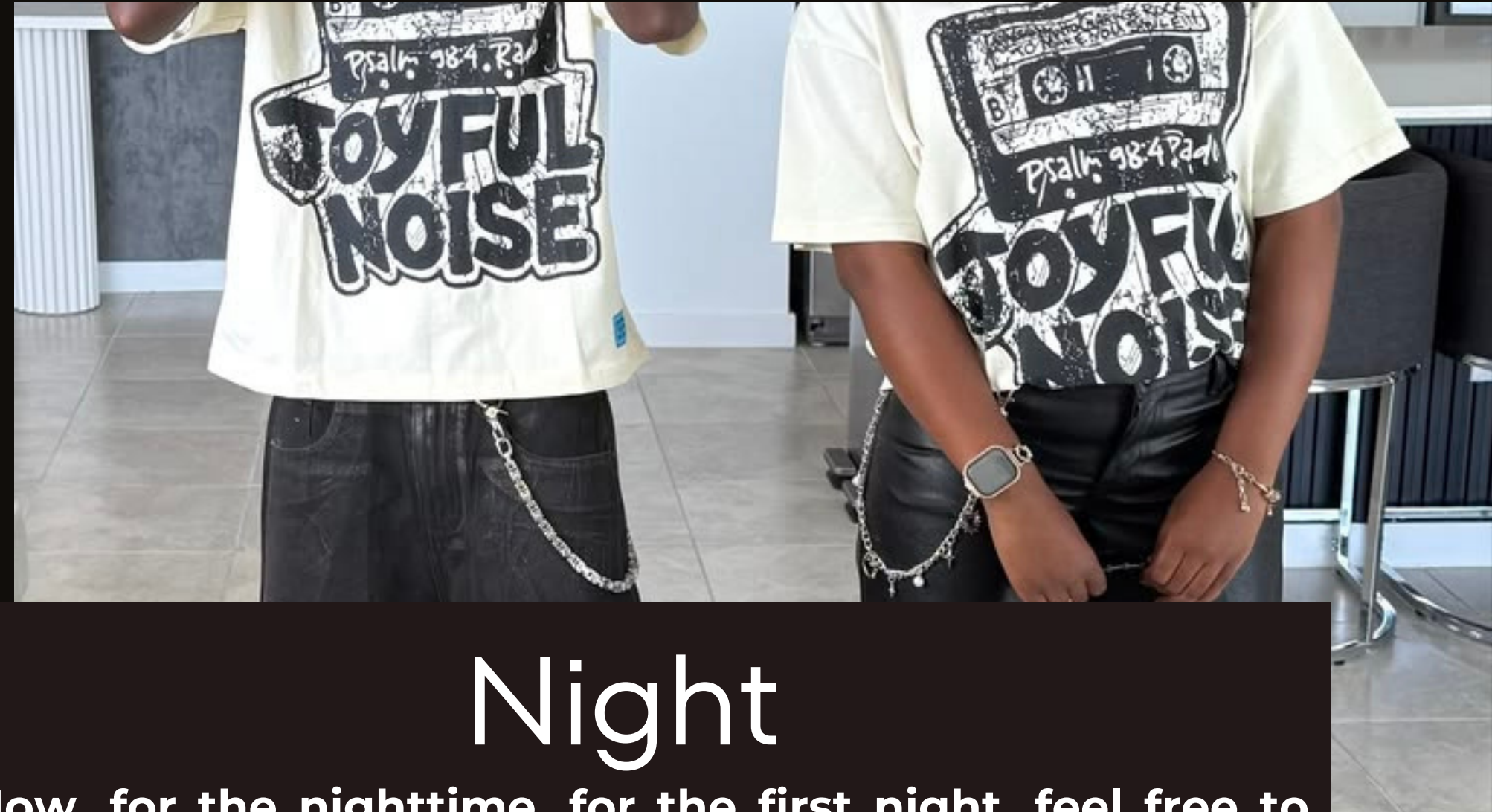
The blues reference classic cowboy and cowgirl denim, worn, faded, and sun-bleached from long days out on the range.

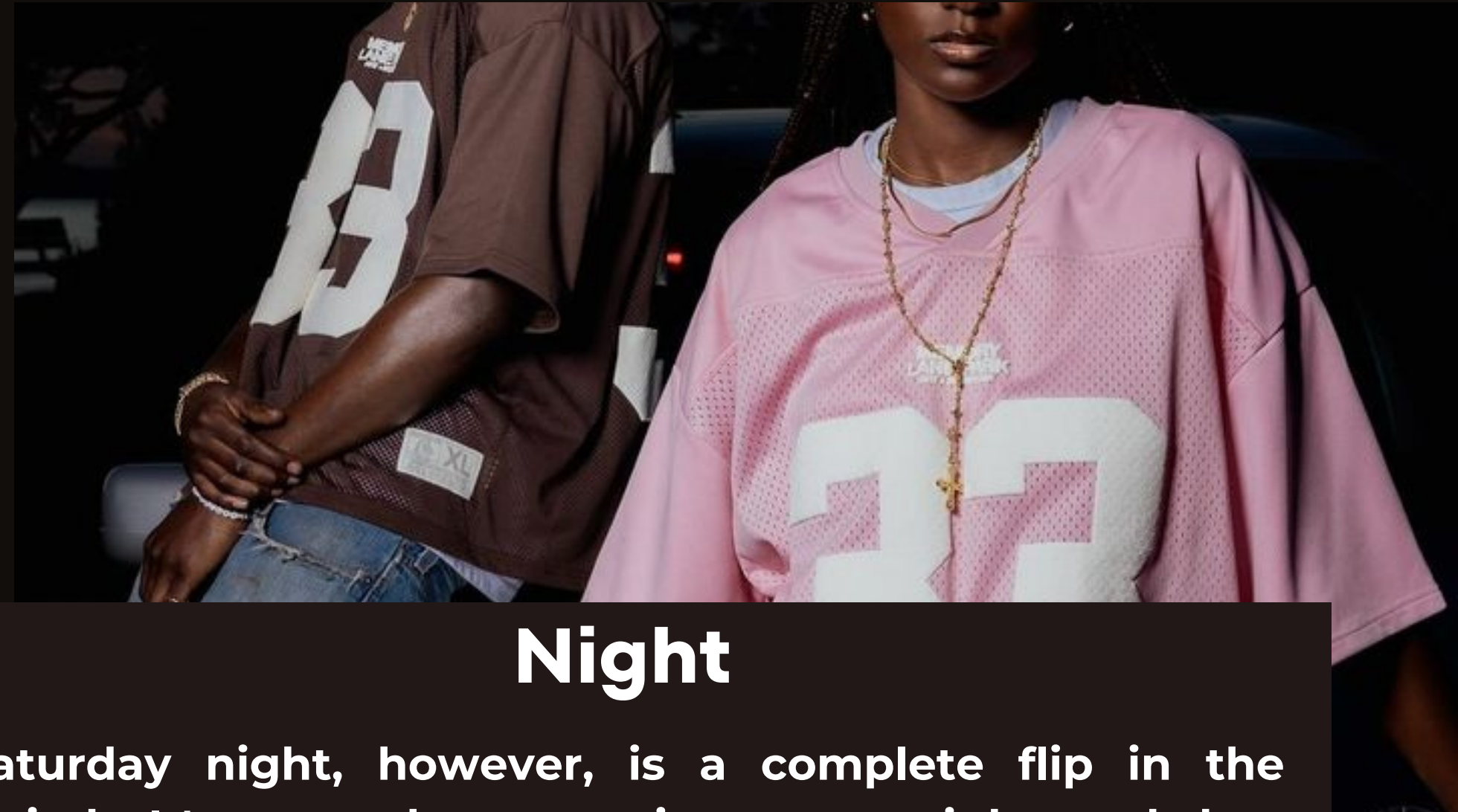

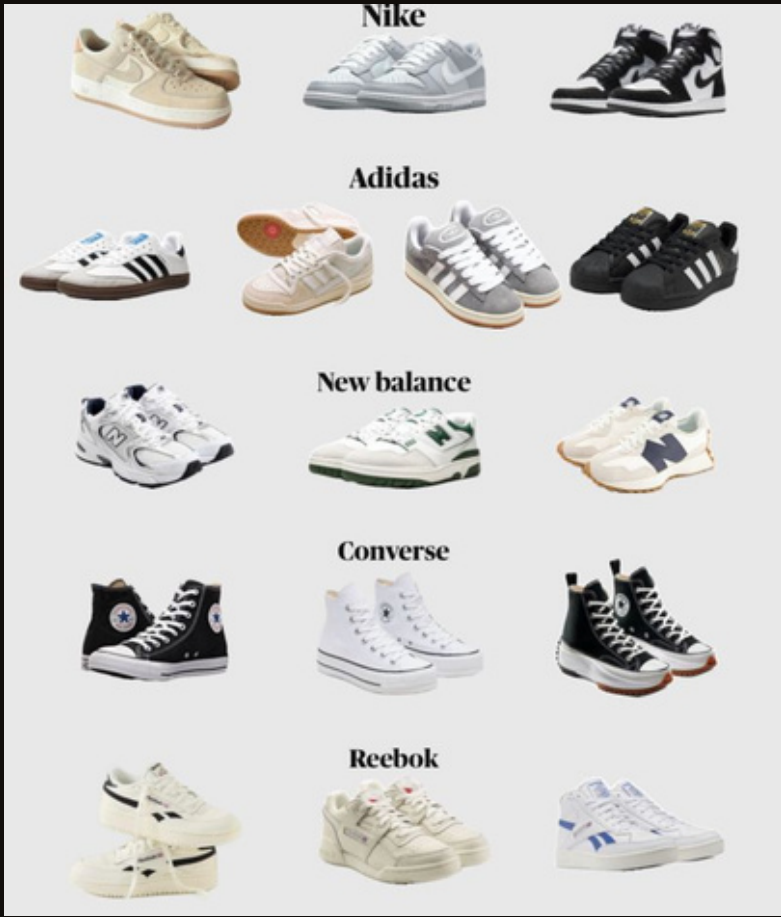

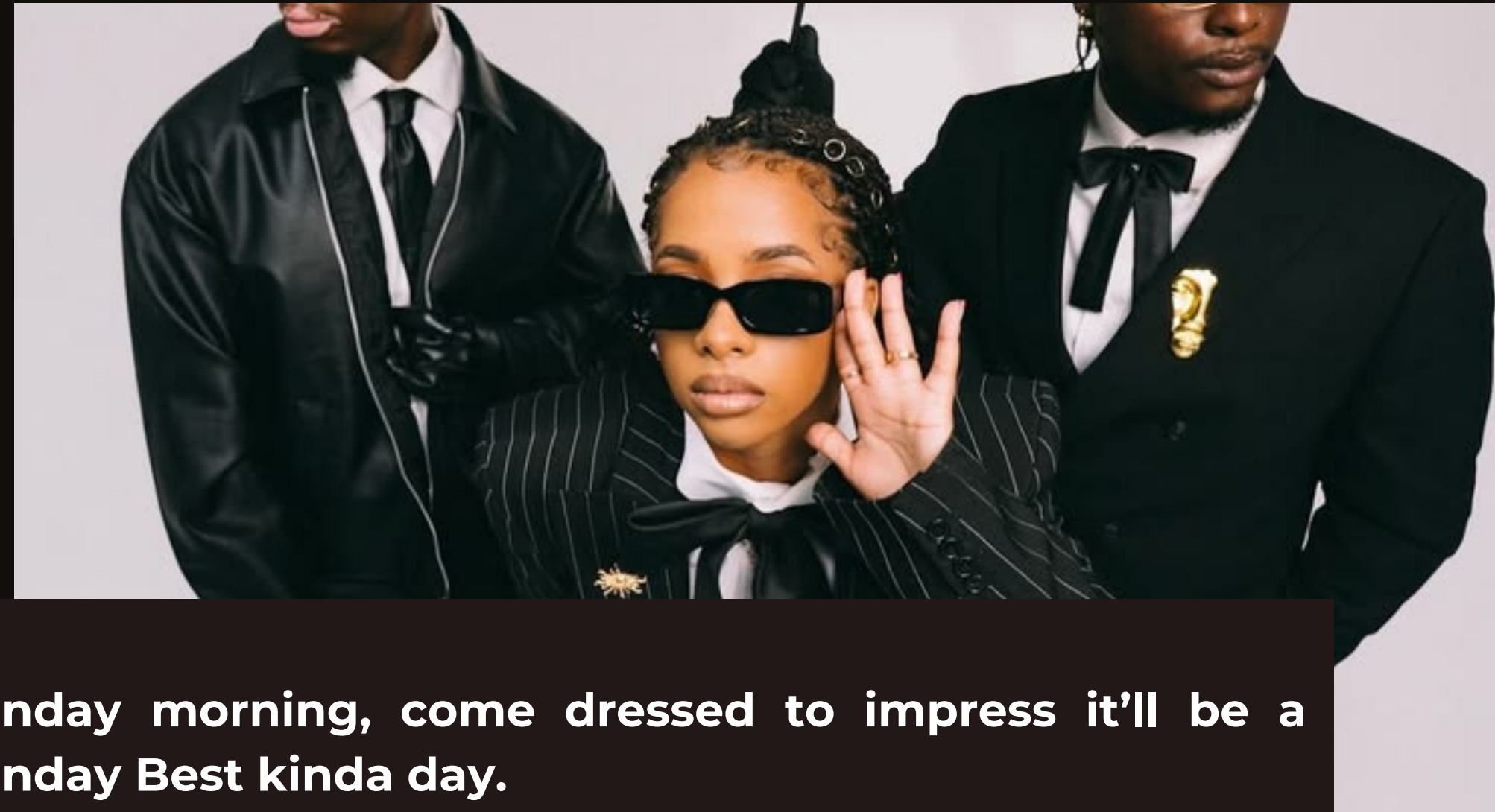


Sunday Day Three Day
